

CAN TATE CONTROL HIS BULLY? BY STAN DANIELS

Frank Rizzo is now Police Commissioner. He is well known for his "tough" bully tactics. Is he qualified for the job? Is he a fair unbiased cop? Does he believe in EQUALITY before the law? Is he prejudiced? Is he brutal?

Many question Mayor Tate's wisdom in appointing Frank Rizzo as Police Commissioner. People are asking "Can Tate control his 'Bully'?" Will Tate (or the next mayor) have to fire this man who is known to many as "Little Hitler" or "Mussolini the Second"? Let's deal with some of these questions:

Is Rizzo qualified for his job? If ALL that the job requires is a forceful man with a strong hand on a club and a quick draw on the gun -- then there is no question about his qualifications. If, on the other hand, an understanding of HUMAN BEINGS, along with their many stresses and problems, is needed then there are many serious questions about his abilities. His statements (including a recent TV appearance) indicate a reliance on FORCE, "quckly and sternly" mustered, as the ONLY means of dealing with the public.

Is Rizzo a fair, unbiased cop, and does he believe in equality before the law? The ADA and several other groups in this city say NO! Many feel that he stir up racial hatreds and has "different strokes for different folks." He did NOT "quckly and sternly" enforce



the law on Roosevelt Boulevard during the labor dispute when the trucks were overturned. Policemen were attacked and doused with paint in Kensington. Rizzo himself took a WEEK to arrive on the scene in this Irish-Catholic community. Why? Even then, he did not show anywhere near the same amount of "stern law enforcement" that was shown at Girard College and the State Building.

WILL RIZZO COMMIT SUICIDE IF

THERE IS NO RIOT THIS SUMMER? Many of Mr. Rizzo's statements indicate that he expects a "long, hot summer." He says that "Phila-

delphia policemen have come a long way from the riot of '64 and are well prepared." Who is preparing for a riot besides Rizzo? Is he trying to start one with his "tough" talk and "open challenges" what will he do if the PEOPLE DON'T RIOT? What will he do with all the new riot gear? Can he function if he is not the CENTER of attention?

WHERE DOES B'NAI B'RITH STAND

The B'nai B'rith has spoken out in Rizzo's favor. So has the Jewish War Veterans Post 77. Would these same organizations support Hitler or Mussolini? Do these groups feel that FORCE is the only way to deal with people and with tense situations? Can a man who so many people regard as a "Bully" really enforce the law "equally for ALL the people, regardless of race, creed or color?" Germany and Italy once had men in power who "played favorites" and used "stern force" -- the result is bloody history.

WILL THERE BE A RIZZO "COUP"

Will Tate allow Philadelphia to become a "Little Third Reich?" Is a stick and gun now the only requirement for Police Commissioner? What is the standard -- BRAINS or BRAVN? Will Mayor Tate wake up one morning and find that Rizzo has staged a "coup" and taken over City Hall?

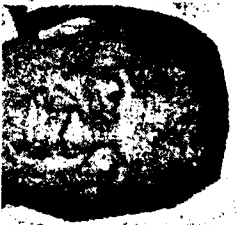
